

A DAY IN HYBRID LEARNING



Arrival

- Caregivers should check their student's health before they leave for school. Students with symptoms should stay home.
- Student drop off begins at 8:30am
- All students will have a health screening before entering school.
- Students who do not pass the screening will be sent home.
- If driving, caregivers will wait until their student passes the screening before driving away.
- Students who do not have a mask will be provided one.
- Students will wait in the socially distanced cafeteria until the school day begins. Breakfast will be served at this time.

BUS RIDERS

- Caregivers will conduct a health assessment before students leave the house. Caregivers must keep students home if they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- Masks required at bus stops and on bus
- Students will be lined up and board bus from front to back, as to not pass each other during boarding.
- Distancing of 6 feet apart when possible at both bus stops and on bus.
- Students will receive assigned seats on busses, and are not allowed to change seats.
- Students will sanitize hands when boarding bus.
- Every bus will be disinfected by the driver after each run. Bus will be disinfected after morning and afternoon routes have been completed.

Daily Health Screening Questions

Help us keep ACPA safe by asking your student the following questions before their "in school" days:

YES or NO since your last day in the building have you had any of the following?

1. A new fever (100.4 or higher)?
2. New shortness of breath that cannot be attributed to another health condition?
3. New chills that cannot be attributed to another health conditions?
4. New muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity (such as physical exercise)?
5. Have you, or anyone you have been in close contact with, been diagnosed with COVID-19 or placed in quarantine for possible exposure to COVID-19?

School Day Between Classes

- School staff will assist students in following directions, adhering to safety protocols, maintaining physical distancing, and finding classrooms.
- Students will move between classrooms for each period, walking in marked "lanes", 6 feet apart as often as possible.
- Teachers will wipe down hard surfaces between classes.
- Students must maintain social distancing while using the restrooms.
- Students will carry their materials in a backpack/bag - no lockers.

School Day In the Classroom

- Student desks spaced 6 ft. apart
- All members of school community must wear masks.
- Students will use ACPA-issued Chromebook for school work - the computer must be charged before coming to school each day.
- During group work and collaborative activities, 6 ft. separation will be maintained.
- There will not be shared materials between students in the same class period.

Foundations

- All classes will adhere to safety regulations and protocols.
- All equipment will comply with mandated cleaning protocols.
- Students will not use locker rooms.

Meals/Breaks

- Students will eat breakfast in lunch in cafeteria or outside, weather permitting, maintaining physical distancing.
- School staff will supervise students during meals to ensure safety protocols are followed.
- Students will not have access to microwaves, water fountains, or refrigeration.

Dismissal

- Students must be picked up at 4:05pm.
- No after-school programming or waiting room at this time.
- Students will dismiss to busses as they arrive.
- Students will wait outside if they are being picked up, appropriately distanced and supervised.
- Caregivers will have limited access to the building.



COVID-19 Response

- Students and staff who present COVID-like symptoms during the school day, after consulting with designated staff, will be escorted to an isolation room to wait while until able to leave the building.
- Only legal guardians or designated emergency contacts will be allowed to pick up students.
- Students excluded from attending school due to COVID-like symptoms will require clearance from a medical provider to return.
- Families will be notified of potential or definite exposure via email within 24hrs.
