Dismissal

- Students must be picked up at 4:05pm.
- No after-school programming or waiting room at this
- Students will dismiss to busses as they arrive. Students will wait outside if they are being picked up,

- Caregivers will have limited access to the building.

COVID-19 Response

- Students and staff who present COVID-like symptoms during the school day, after consulting with designated staff, will be escorted to an isolation room to wait until able to leave the building. Only legal guardians or designated emergency
- only legal guardans or designated enlergency contacts will be allowed to pick up students. Students excluded from attending school due to COVID-like symptoms will require clearance from a medical provider to return.
- Families will be notified of potential or definite exposure via email within 24hrs.
