



Dear parents and caretakers of 11th grade students,

All juniors will be taking the state/district ACT as part of the state of Ohio graduation requirements. ACPA will be administering the ACT **at ACPA on March 9, 2022 beginning at 9:00am.** The following letter details important information regarding the administration of the test on March 9, 2022.

Administration of the test:

- **Breakfast will be served from 8:00-8:50am.**
 - Juniors will be offered a **free coffee drink** and be able to skip ahead of the line when they arrive.
 - Regular breakfast hours begin at 8:30 - only juniors are allowed to eat from 8:00-8:30am.
- **Testing will begin promptly at 9:00am.**
 - Bus riders are encouraged to reach out to friends and family to arrange a different mode of transportation for the day in order to arrive on time.
 - Contact Kati Nelson (614-986-9974) for any transportation issues.
- **Students must bring in their ACPA chrome books and charger to use for the ACT.** It must be the ACPA Chromebook because it will have the ACT software on it. Do not bring another laptop.
- Students should bring a personal calculator if they have one. (Graphic calculators are permitted)
- Staff will be on hand to assist students throughout the day.
- Students will be dismissed after completion of the test to attend the remainder of the school day.
