Ohio's State Tests - End of Course Exams

- Students in grades nine through twelve who are enrolled in the following courses: English Language Arts II, Algebra I, Geometry (or Integrated Mathematics I and II), Biology, American History, and Government.
- Students enrolled in grade seven - English Language Arts and Mathematics.
- Students enrolled in grade eight - English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science.

Ohio's State Tests

- Students who have previously tested in the above subjects, but have not yet met the minimum required graduation points will retake one or more test(s). Counselors and administration will notify students and families who need to participate in retake exams and intervention will be available to help students prepare.

ACT (College Entrance Exam)

- All students in the 2025 graduating class will take the ACT at ACPA this year on March 5, 2024. This administration of the ACT is free for students. Students electing to take the ACT at another time outside of ACPA are responsible for the fee of that administration.

Additionally, parents and guardians have the right to request information regarding their student's achievement levels on any state-mandated test administered at ACPA.
