



ACPA High School Device Policy

Dear ACPA Families,

An important change is taking place at ACPA High School this year. We will not be permitting wireless communication devices at ACPA. Please see the policy below:

ACPA High School has a no Wireless Communication Device policy. Students are expected to refrain from using wireless communication and/or entertainment devices during instructional time unless expressly authorized by an instructor or staff member as an instructional tool. Examples of wireless communication devices include but are not limited to smartphones, cellular phones, Wi-Fi enabled devices, video broadcasting devices, laptops, tablets, game systems, headphones that enable Bluetooth technology, smart watches, and other devices that allow a person to access or view sound or video.

If at any time the possession of a wired or wireless device creates a distraction, disruption, safety or security hazard on school property, at a school sponsored event or on a school sponsored vehicle such device(s) will be confiscated. School officials are not responsible for the security of confiscated wireless devices.

We know that emergency situations may arise when you need to communicate with your student. Please contact the school, and our front desk will pass the message along to your student or connect you with your student.

We appreciate your help in communicating with your student about the change in policy and the expectations in not using devices during instructional time.
