In order to qualify for the Student Engagement Seal, a student must meet at least one of the two criteria below:

- 1. Demonstrate an active commitment to APCA organizations, clubs, or extracurriculars through one of the following:
  - Active involvement or participation in 2 different organizations, each for
     2 or more years. Requires at least 1 staff signature for each organization.
  - Having a leadership role in 1 organization throughout 1 year. A
    leadership role is a position in which a student is responsible for some or all
    of an organization's function or performance. Requires at least 1 staff
    signature.
  - A combination of the two points above, which entails participation in 1
     organization for 2 or more years <u>and</u> having a leadership role within that
     organization for one semester or less. Requires at least 1 staff signature.
     Examples of when this may apply include situations such as:
    - Being involved in both the Fall Play and Spring Musical for 2 years, but only having a lead role in the Fall play (a semester-long role).
    - Participating in Drag Club for 2 years, and taking on a leadership role beginning in the 2nd year's spring semester.
- 2. Demonstrate significant school engagement through an initiative effort to support other students, staff, or the school as a whole, through at least one of the following:
  - A regular willingness to assist students and/or staff in developing a positive school environment or culture. Requires at least 2 staff signatures. Examples include:
    - Frequently assisting staff with transporting or constructing furniture, equipment, or other classroom supplies.
    - Frequently collaborating with staff and students to address school needs using the ACPA values
  - A willingness to assist staff or the school in at least three significant tasks, functions, or programs that a student would not normally participate in. Requires at least 1 staff signature for each instance of staff/school assistance. Examples include:
    - Helping a school counselor with organizing a college fair.
    - Being a consistent and effective peer tutor during a test prep program.

School administration will determine whether assistance with a particular task, function, or program qualifies as significant or regular school engagement.

In all cases where examples are given, the list of examples is not comprehensive and other situations may apply.

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Document your student engagement on the table below. The number of organizations/roles needed to earn the seal is dependent on the type of engagement that is demonstrated.
